

In 2015, about 2.4 million Americans had opioid use disorders and nearly 80 percent did not receive treatment.<sup>1</sup>



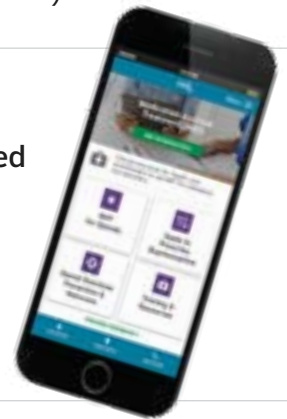
## MATx Mobile App

The free MATx Mobile App empowers health care practitioners to provide effective, evidence-based care for opioid use disorders by providing information on treatment, medications, and clinical resources.

MATx supports practitioners who currently provide medication-assisted treatment (MAT).

### Features of the MATx app:

- Provides information on how to approach treatment and medications approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for treatment of opioid use disorders.
- Buprenorphine Prescribing Guide.
- Clinical support with training and resources.
